Begin your international study abroad experience with Northeast. Seventy students from 24 countries attended Northeast in 2018. Among these, Brazil, Burkina Faso and Colombia produced the largest number of incoming students.

Complete a two-year degree and start your career or transfer to a four-year college.

If you began your college education at another institution in the United States, you can easily transfer to Northeast.

You must have a high school diploma or equivalent from your home country to apply. If you are admitted, Northeast's Center for Global Engagement staff will work alongside you through the student visa process.

About the Area

Nebraska is a state, located in the center of the United States.

Norfolk, Nebraska is in northeastern Nebraska. It is 113 miles northwest of Omaha, Nebraska and 83 miles west of Sioux City, Iowa.

The population of Norfolk is 23,348 (as of 2016).



What is required for admission to Northeast?

English Language Proficiency:

You must provide test scores from IELTS, TOEFL (61 or above), SAT/ACT or a certificate of completion from a certified language school in the U.S.A.

Proof of high school completion or diploma, translated into English.

Proof of financial capability: a bank statement or certified letter from a bank showing all expenses can be covered.

A copy of your passport.

Health insurance that is valid in the United States.

F-1 Visa: apply through your embassy after you have been officially accepted as a student.

International Application: must be filled out and submitted. The application can be found at: northeast.edu/Admissions/International under Application Steps.

Deadlines for submission are:

July 1 for fall term
(August to December)

November 15 for spring term
(January to May)

Certain programs may need an additional application filled out and/or require a Fall program start date.

What are the costs?

Our estimated cost of attendance for the 2019-2020 academic year for international students is \$16,627.00.

This includes tuition and fees, housing and food, travel, insurance and books and supplies.

An F-1 student visa requires all students to enroll in at least 12 credit hours. There are very strict off-campus work requirements, and on-campus work is limited. Northeast is able to offer a very low tuition rate compared to other schools; there is no reduction in fees available.

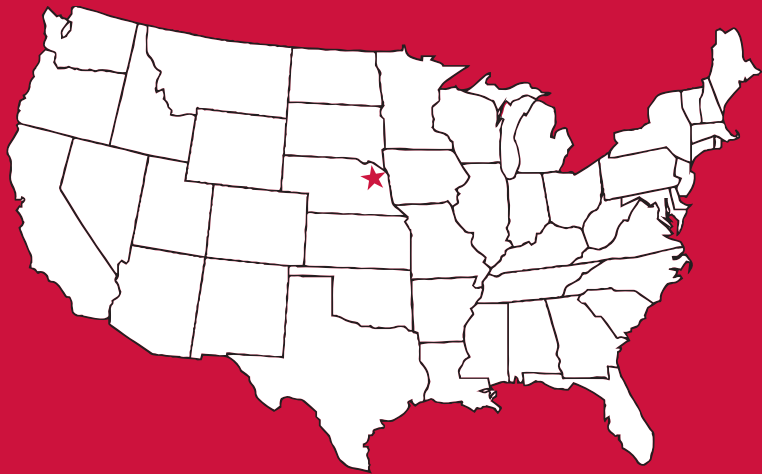
