

# **COURSE DELIVERY METHODS FOR DUAL CREDIT**

Northeast Community College will be offering dual credit courses in multiple delivery methods. On your class schedule, you will likely notice changes in the "Location" of classes. Course locations will be one of the following options:

#### **DUAL CREDIT**

Students and instructor meet in a designated classroom at specified day(s) and time. Some coursework may be submitted online through Canvas.

### **DUAL CREDIT ONLINE**

Location will show as **OLIN**. Course is asynchronous with no designated meeting day or time. Students will log into Canvas to access and submit assignments by designated deadlines. The course instructor is available for questions and assistance, usually through email or by appointment through video conferencing. Access to a computer and reliable Internet is necessary.

#### **VIRTUAL DUAL CREDIT**

Course location will be shown as VIRT. The course is synchronous and will meet via video conferencing at the day(s) and time shown in the course schedule. Instructions for logging into the video conference can be found in the course information in Canvas. Access to a computer, a webcam, and reliable Internet is necessary.

## **DUAL CREDIT ONLINE**

Course is asynchronous with no designated day or time. Location will show as **OLIN**. The course will be offered online through Canvas without the constraints of having to log on at a certain time or be at a certain place. You will need to meet the assignment deadlines outlined in the course syllabus. Weekly assignments and due dates are components of the course.

#### **HYBRID VIRTUAL DUAL CREDIT**

This delivery method combines Virtual and Online delivery methods. Hybrid Virtual courses meet via video conferencing at designated day(s) and times for a shorter timeframe than Virtual courses, and part of the course is also completed online. Access to a computer, a webcam, and reliable Internet is necessary.
