



Application Packet

The Davis Chambers Scholarship Program has been established to recognize academically promising students from diverse backgrounds. Awardees will receive up to \$2,000.00 per academic year.

You should apply for this scholarship if you meet the following qualifications and **plan** to attend one of the Nebraska Community Colleges.

- I have knowledge or experience living or working in a diverse community or organization
- I am an academically promising student, active in my school or community
- I will be a full-time student during 2025-2026
- I graduated or will graduate from a Nebraska high school, or I have earned a GED
- I am a U.S. citizen and a Nebraska resident
- I have financial need based on the results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

The number of scholarships and the amount of each scholarship vary according to the availability of funds and the financial need of the recipient(s). **Please review the entire application packet thoroughly.** It includes an instruction page, a checklist, and the application.

Application Deadline
April 1, 2025



The terms of your Davis Chambers Scholar Commitments are as follows:

1. An amount equal to one-half of your annual commitment will be credited to your centralized billing account each term.
2. You must enroll for at least 12 credit hours (nine graded hours) during each academic year term (fall, winter, and spring quarters) and successfully complete 24 credit hours each academic year. Repeated courses only count once.
3. This commitment will be discontinued if you withdraw from school or fail to register during the next four academic years unless an exception is granted in advance of the period of absence because of special circumstances.
4. All Davis Chambers Scholars are generally expected to maintain a cumulative grade point of 2.25 or higher throughout their years of undergraduate study.
5. You will be required to be an active participant as determined by your institution and as outlined in your agreement letter.
6. You must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after October 1 each year and not later than March 1 if you wish to be considered for more than the minimum commitment of \$2,000. The FAFSA application can be filed electronically at <http://www.fafsa.gov>.
7. The Davis Chambers Scholarship recognizes academically promising students who often find that the financial requirements of postsecondary education are a major obstacle. The scholarship may be used for (tuition, room and board, or fees). **Each applicant is required to complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The scholarship is applied after all other aid.**

How to Apply for the Davis Chambers Scholarship

This application may be used by students applying for admission to (or who are already admitted to) any of the following Nebraska Community Colleges:

- Central Community College
- Metropolitan Community College
- Mid-Plains Community College
- Northeast Community College
- Southeast Community College
- Western Nebraska Community College

1. **Apply for Admission.** If you are not already a student, select the Community College you want to attend. Contact the Admissions Office of that College (see listing below) and follow all procedures to gain admission.
2. **Take a College Placement Test.** Each college Admissions Office will advise you of the appropriate placement test and inform you of the times, dates, and fees involved. This testing will help identify your present skill level and aid you in selecting appropriate courses to ensure your initial success in college.
3. **File a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).** The value of the Davis Chambers Scholarship is based primarily on the family’s ability to help meet college costs. The financial aid office must be able to determine your financial need. If you have not already done so, contact your community college’s Financial Aid Office (see below). Follow all procedures to apply for financial aid, including filing the 2025-26 FAFSA form, as additional resources may be available to students with financial need.
4. **Complete the Davis Chambers Scholarship Application (attached).** Include your written responses to the essay question and required transcripts.
5. **Send the completed packet to the respective college by April 1, 2025.**
